While general farm management systems do exist for orchards and permanent crops—covering functions like irrigation tracking, pollination, harvesting, and inventory—none explicitly focus on date palms or Medjool varieties.

Although many of these systems support API integration with accounting software, they typically require custom configuration to accommodate palm-specific workflows such as bunch thinning, pollen management, and offshoot tracking.
